Cuevas? Remote learning - the money that is there will it be for digital books? Or will it be paid with library or remote learning money?

Mr. Ocon: We will be separating the library and remote learning money. We need to buy digital books for the students to have access to it.

Maybe it is not enough money. But we may have to add later more money to for teachers to train for remote learning.

Cuevas: If all sports cancel and we have bucket money. Can we remove money from those buckets? Can we allocate that money?

Barnes: Yes, we can re-allocate those funds wherever it needs to be utilized.

Cuevas: Mr. Ocon has done a lot of summer programs at Juarez. If it gets canceled what will happen to the money for the summer programs?

Barnes: Physically they will offer remote learning. Those funds need to be reallocated if they decide that all summer programs are canceled.

Mr. Ocon: We are still in communication with Chicago Park District who utilizes the building for summer programs. But it may be that they cancel the activities and we have been in conversations with organizations. We are waiting for orders from the Government and Mayor.

Mr. Ocon: Yes, it will continue. We have also distributed diapers, formula and masks. We will continue as a center of distribution.

Mr. Ocon: We are number 1 in distributing computer to our students.

Ms. Castillo: Monday's workshop with parents. 8 parents who have been attending this workshop how to help our students during this difficult time? Ms. Ramirez and Ms. Mendez are wonderful helping our parents during this time.

Did not approve: Campoverde

Mr. Ocon: How much money is this money all together? 16million Campoverde: 16 million to overview in an hour is not enough and her vote is no and no participation with the public. One of the rules is to present to the community. How do you want me to approve a 16 million when there is no public participation?

Mr. Ocon: We do not have control of the 16 million.
