- 1. Call meeting to order
  - a. 5:05 p.m.
- 2. Roll call
  - a. Esmeralda Bue, Beatriz Castillo, Pedro Hernandez, Alicia Fraga, Alfredo Peralta, Nancy Bigelow, Angel Cruz, Ingrid Garcia, Oscar Torres, Glenda Campoverde, Ismael Cuevas
- 3. Approved minutes
  - a. Mr. Ocon noted meeting time for LSC on 12/4/19 was set @ 5:00 p.m. not @ 5:30 p.m.
  - b. Motion to approve Beatriz Castillo
  - c. Seconded Juan Carlos Ocon
  - d. Approved -8 in favor
- 4. New business
  - a. Julissa Cruz had been invited by Mr. Ocon to join us for principal evaluation & committee rules, but informed she was unable to attend
  - b. St. Procopius
    - i. Juarez is always present for Novena to our Lady of Guadalupe
    - ii. Letter was given to LSC to inform and invite everyone
  - c. CTE Updates
    - i. No instructor has been found yet
    - ii. Been looking for instructor since June
    - iii. Last application was received at the end of September
    - iv. Mr. Ocon mentions how during the last meeting he asked LSC to consider the possibility of closing off program for reasons already stated
    - v. Students, if program is closed, will have to be moved to other programs
    - vi. Mr. Ocon already spoke to CPS to brainstorm other alternative/potential programs for automotive students could join
    - vii. Potential list of programs sophomores, juniors & seniors was handed to LSC
    - viii. Ms. Bigelow asked what "no 3<sup>rd</sup> period options available" meant
    - ix. Mr. Ocon said 3<sup>rd</sup> period simply means that's not an option. Only those classes listed are options
    - x. Again, Mr. Ocon informs LSC that a decision as far as closing program, will have to be made by January
    - xi. CTE updates certifications will begin this month in December
    - xii. This means students (seniors) will be able to earn brake & electrical certification
    - xiii. If automotive program closes, Juarez can apply for a new CTE program
    - xiv. Mr. Ocon believes the "Education & Training" is the best fit for Juarez out of all the programs
    - xv. Application for programs begin in January. Mr. Ocon asked LSC to begin considering options
    - xvi. Ismael asked if IBW-Solar program is embedded in automotive program; Mr. Ocon said is separate
  - d. Beatriz asked if new date could be scheduled for principal evaluation committee
    - i. Meeting was scheduled for today 12/4

- ii. Ms. Bigelow asked if meeting could still continue even if Mr. Ocon, who is scheduled to leave @ 6:00 p.m. today, due to previously scheduled event, could still continue
- iii. Beatriz asked to reschedule today's principal evaluation informal meeting to take place on 12/11 @ 5:30 p.m.
- iv. Ismael said having the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting next week on 12/11 would be too soon to initiate principal evaluation committee meet
- v. Mr. Peralta suggested committee meet until Ms. Cruz can join them for the meeting to help with rules & guidelines
- vi. Is mael motioned to have  $1^{\rm st}$  principal evaluation meeting on 12/11 @ 5:30 p.m. with Ms. Cruz presence

  - i. Per Ms. Mendiola's observation incorrect meeting time was posted for today's meeting
  - ii. Ms. Mendiola asked to consider allotting time to present info to/for PPLC
- e. Ms. Griselda Zamora express gratitude toward Mr. Ocon & also suggested visit the school. How welcomed she always felt
- f. Ms. Elonda Smith-Neris spoke about how she felt her evaluation and ultimately her termination, were based on possible racial discrimination
  - i. She believes she was evaluated unfairly especially because she had never been written up before
  - ii. She believes this 2<sup>nd</sup> time she was let go was due to retaliation
  - iii. She said that she was evaluated based on factors that weren't part of her job description
  - iv. Ismael says that he along with other LSC members are unaware of LSC's role on this matter
  - v. Ms. Campoverde believes we, LSC, should question Mr. Ocon on what played into Ms. Smith-Neris termination
  - vi. Ismael said LSC would look into the matter and see if there's a pattern
- g. Ms. Susan Gonzalez said she came to see what an LSC meeting is like
  - i. Ms. Gonzalez asked LSC to please consider all factors when evaluating Mr. Ocon
  - ii. She mentioned her daughter has/had a great experience at Juarez
  - iii. She highlights the school's program as well as the efforts made that have brought positive changes
